

14.3 How do you produce a report from saved measurement results?

When you return to your office or hotel from making on-site measurements, you will want to or have to produce a measurement report. That is the goal of any measurement campaign, and anything that saves time doing this is welcome. The broadband meter [Narda NBM](#) and selective meter [Narda SRM](#) have lots of features that can help. For one, both devices record all the device parameters for the measurement results, so you don't have to laboriously copy down serial numbers, calibration data and so on, and enter them in your report. In fact, the devices also record the date, time and even the position if there is GPS reception. Just one click, and the PC software converts the GPS data into a map. What's more, most instruments are equipped with a microphone and voice recorder and can replay your dictated comments via a PC as needed. You can throw away your clipboard and pencil. You can even import your house logo and the photos you took on your phone. All done!
